How to find us:

Gosport Premier Marina

By Rail/Foot

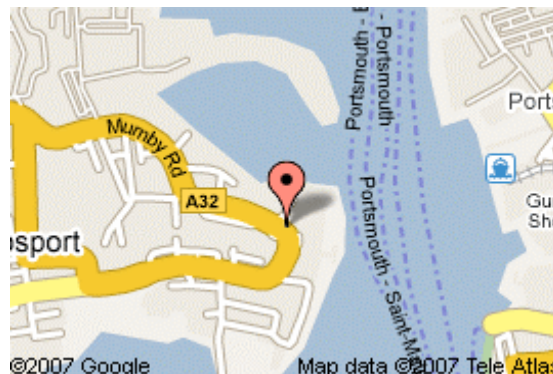
Trains depart regularly from London and tickets and times can be checked at www.thetrainline.com. Disembark at Portsmouth Harbour Station (end of the line). There is a ferry that takes you across the harbour.

Exit the station building and turn immediately left to the Gosport Ferry Pontoon (www.gosportferry.co.uk/ferryservices.php). You will need change for your ticket (£2.30 return, please keep your ticket for the return trip). Tickets can be purchased from the ticket machines at the top of the ramp that takes you down to the ferry, stay in left hand queue. The ferries run every 7 minutes and the crossing takes 5 minutes. When you leave the Gosport Ferry, exit the tunnel and continue straight ahead up the road. To your right is a pub called The Castle Tavern, and the entrance to Gosport Marina is the first turning on the right, just past the Pub. Ondeck is in the new glass fronted building.

Please note: It is also possible to get a taxi from Fareham railway station to Gosport Marina (By the Gosport Ferry). It takes 15-20 minutes and costs about £15. There is a taxi rank outside the station or you can book in advance with Dave's Taxis on 07979 805760 or Streamline Taxis 02392 522222.

By Road

Gosport is accessible from the M27 (J11), which can be reached by the M3 or A3. When you leave the motorway (J11), follow the road for Fareham and Gosport – you will come to a roundabout. Stay in the left lane. Turn left (you go under the train viaduct) and follow the signs for 'Gosport A32' and stay in the left lane. Go straight over the roundabout, keep to the left on the dual carriageway and, after the petrol station, take the left turning signposted Gosport (do not go over the flyover).



Continue along the A32 for Gosport. Approx 6 miles along this road is Gosport town centre. As you approach the centre, there is a Pub on your left called **The Castle Tavern**. The entrance to Gosport Marina is immediately before the Pub. Parking is available at £4 per day in the Marina car park to the left through the barriers. Please take a ticket.

By Air

The closest airport is Southampton International Airport. You can get a train from Southampton Parkway to Portsmouth Harbour or Fareham by changing at Southampton Central. Alternatively a taxi to Gosport will be about £35 with Dave's taxis 07979 805 760, please agree the fare before travelling. There are also direct trains from Gatwick Airport to Fratton, Portsmouth. (5 minute taxi from the Gosport ferry), that takes just over 1.5 Hours.
