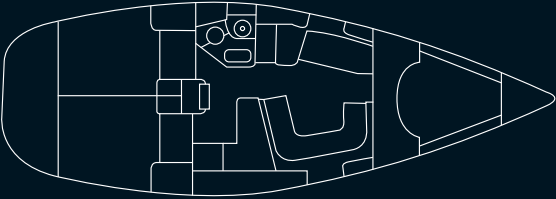

Designed by Jacques Faroux, the Sun Odyssey 37 combines beauty and performance. This personality is perfectly illustrated by the new line of Jeanneau cruising boats. The best example is the smooth roof design (retaining a full standing headroom of 6'4") and the new deck layout designed for efficient sailing.

This Jeanneau has a battened main with single line reefing, lazyjack system, and furling headsail so that the yacht can be sailed from the cockpit which makes this yacht ideal for cruising. For the colder months she has heating and a cockpit protection making this a year round choice for cruising.
